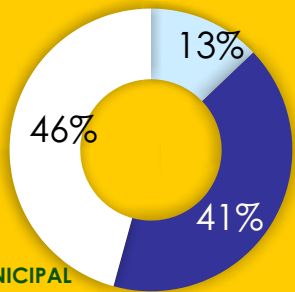

## PROVINCIAL FISHERIES PRODUCTION, by sector, 2014

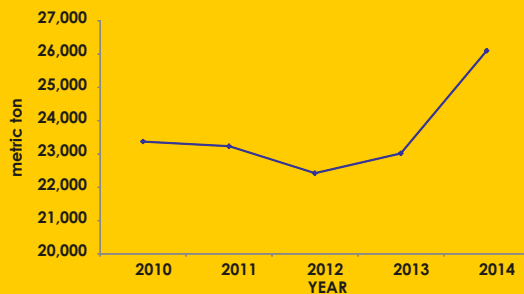
