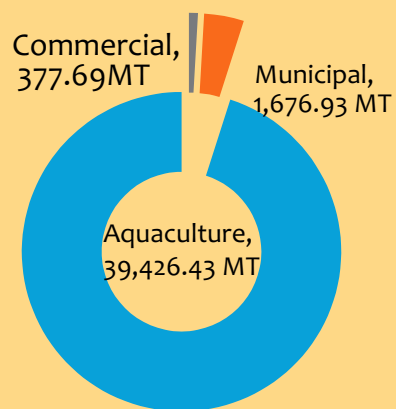
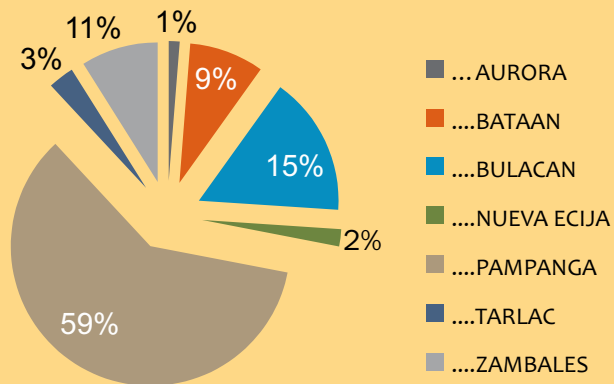


TOTAL PROVINCIAL FISHERIES PRODUCTION BY SECTOR, CY 2014

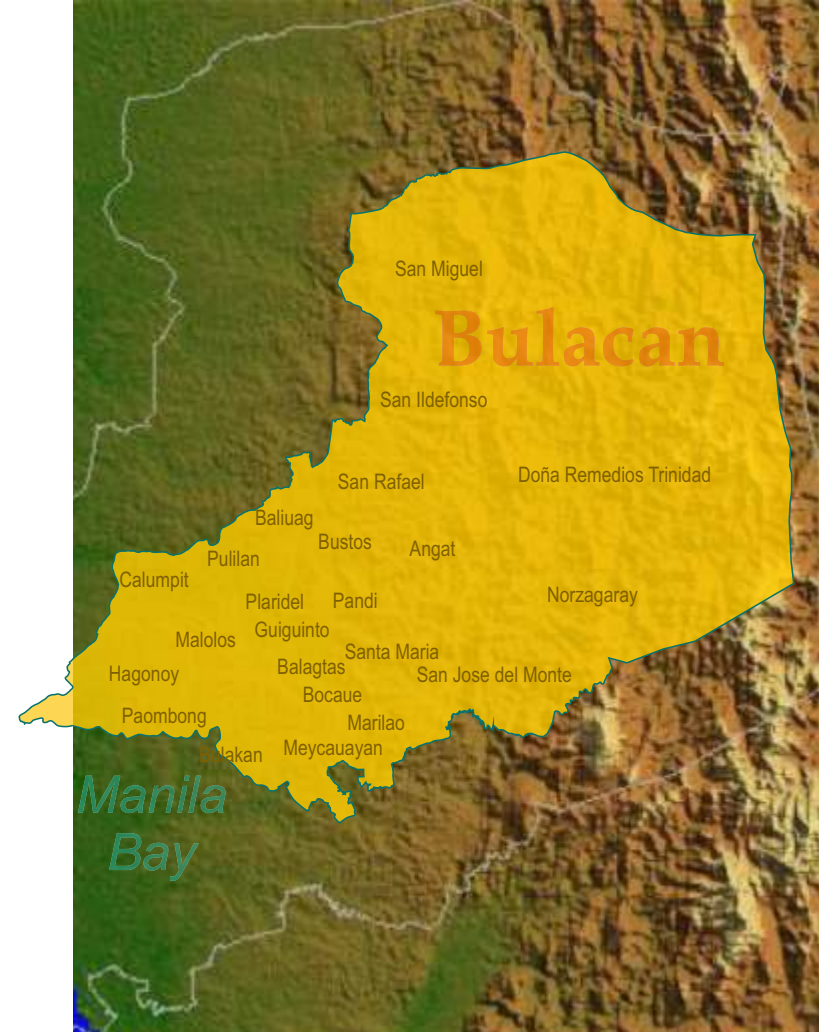


Aquaculture production accounts for 95% of the total provincial fisheries production of 41,418.05 MT in 2014
