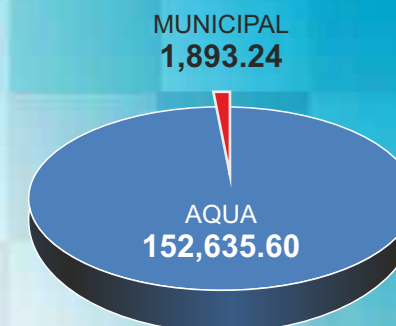

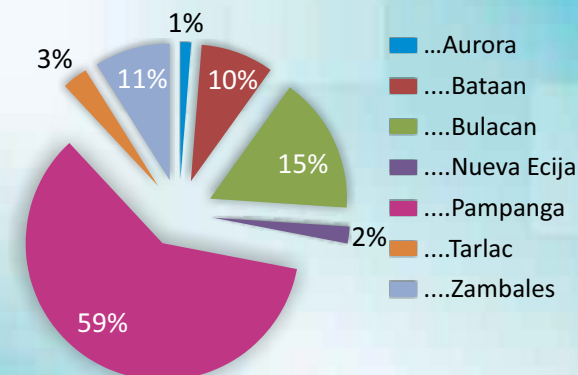
PROVINCIAL FISHERIES PRODUCTION
